The Department of Athletics & Recreation at Capilano University is currently accepting applications for the position of Head Volleyball Coach for their Intercollegiate women's volleyball program, for a one year term, effective April 1, 2012. This contract is renewable.

Reporting to the Director, Athletics and Recreation, this position is responsible for organizing, developing and implementing a women's volleyball program that abides by Capilano University's Coaching Code of Conduct as well as the PACWEST Code of Ethics. You will be responsible for the recruitment and development of players, coaching team practices and league games, coordinating team fundraising and developing a competitive program that encourages sportsmanship, integrity, teamwork and scholarship. The Head Coach will also play a key role in motivating and mentoring student-athletes to succeed academically and assist the Athletics Department with the organization and implementation of Alumni events.

This is a part-time contract position which requires after school hours, weekend work and some travel. The ideal candidate will have a minimum of 3 years coaching experience (preferably at the post secondary, senior high school, or senior club level) and have demonstrated a high caliber of leadership, sportsmanship and coaching performance. The ideal candidate will also have effective communication and administrative skills with an ability to motivate athletes. The preferred candidate will have a post secondary degree and have attained or be in the process of qualifying for level 2 NCCP Coaching Certification. The successful candidate must hold a valid driver's license.

Contract salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.
