

### Language Department Tuition Award (#0778)

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The Language Department Tuition award was set up by the Language department to encourage students in language courses to continue their language studies at Capilano University. This award will go to a deserving student for tuition (at the domestic tuition rate) and reimbursement of textbooks and/or material costs incurred (up to \$150) when the student registers for a third, or more, course of their chosen language.

**Deadline to Apply:** February 29, 2012 / 4:00pm (submission instructions below)

**Minimum Eligibility Requirements**

- a) Currently enrolled at Capilano University
- b) Must have previously taken a minimum of two courses in one language and has registered for a third language course, or more, in the following term\*
- c) Must be taking or have taken one course in a different language\*
- d) Minimum letter grade of B in all language courses\*
- e) Must submit a statement (no greater than 500 words) explaining why they feel second (third, fourth) language skills are important in today's social/economical/political/cultural context

\* The eligible languages are Chinese, French, German, Japanese and Spanish offered only through Languages in the Faculty of Humanities at Capilano University.
