Pursuant to Section 37 of the College and Institute Act any person who is suspended may request to be heard by the College Board. The College Board will consider appeals only after implementation of the full administrative appeals processes specified in Collective Agreements, Board Employment Policies and Administrative Policies concerning improper behaviour.

Appeals to the Board will be held in camera and the principles of natural justice will apply. Appellants may have representation or counsel present, as may the College. All submissions and decisions must be presented in writing.
