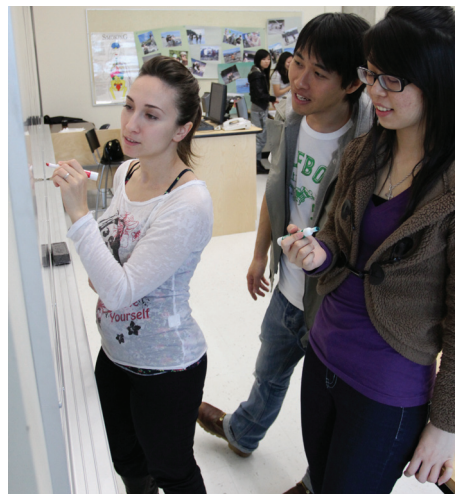

- small class size (25-35 students)

How to Apply

Admission Requirements:

Prospective students are required to meet all of the following admission requirements:

1. High school graduation
2. Minimum age of 18
3. English Language Requirement (one of the following)
 - Min. TOEFL score of 540 PBT/ 200 CBT/ 73 IBT
 - Min. score of 130 on the English Language Assessment Test – ELA (available only in Vancouver)
 - Min. IELTS score of 5.0 overall , with no one score less than 4.5
 - Min. CAEL score of 60
 - Min. PTE Academic score of 49
 - Possible alternatives to waive above English Tests:
Capilano University's ESLF080 with a B+ grade or English 100 with a C+ grade.

Application Procedure:

Applicants must submit the following:

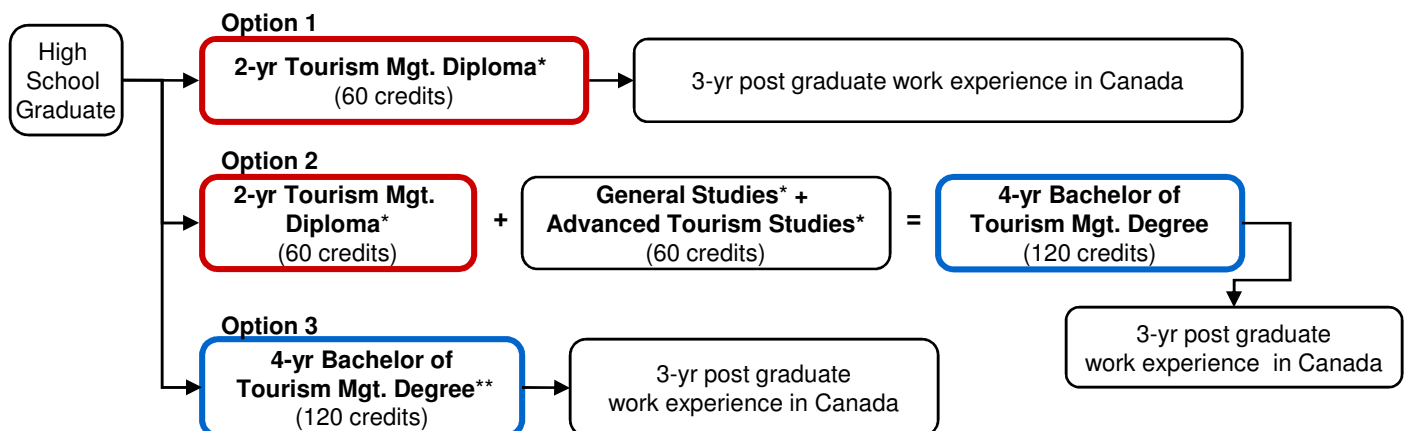
1. A completed application form to Capilano University.
2. A non-refundable application fee.
3. Official transcripts of previous education. (*Photocopies or fax copies will not be accepted.*)
4. An official score from one of the approved English language tests. (*Photocopies or fax copies will not be accepted.*)
5. Two letters of reference.
6. A resume of past experience.
7. A statement outlining why you should be admitted to the program and your employment/career plans following graduation.
8. A min. deposit of \$5000 prior to registration. (*The \$5000 deposit will be put towards your tuition costs for the term.*)

Application Deadline

- 1) Early Application Deadline: 31 March 2) Late Application Deadline: 30 April (*if seats are still available*)

Only complete applications will be reviewed. Your application form and documentation must be received by the above stated dates.
